DEDICATED FIELDS

As mentioned in our last issue, FoSC is keen to get more dedicated fields at our race meetings. Last year, for example, we ran dedicated events for one-make groups and Historic categories, such as Excels, Group S, HTCA, MX-5 Cup, PRBs, VRA, Qld Classic Sports Sedans and the VEK Pulsars.

We'd like to run even more of these – and give you an incentive to put a dedicated field together, for your club or class. Here's what we mean by dedicated fields, and how you could benefit:

FoSC 2016 Dedicated Fields Conditions

1. A dedicated field is a previously agreed exclusive race/regularity field of cars.
2. A minimum of 20 cars is required or the equivalent value entry payment for a dedicated field.
3. A dedicated field of cars **in excess of 20** shall rebate 50% of those entry charges over-20 to the category organiser.
4. A dedicated field of cars **in excess of 25** shall rebate 100% of those entry charge over-25 to the category organiser (within Track Density).
5. Distribution of any rebate is at the discretion of the category organiser.
6. Entries may be paid individually or in bulk.
7. Payment of the full amount must be received by FoSC 21 days prior to the race meeting.
