

TSOA/CSCA Round 3 9 July 2023 Sydney Dragway Sprints

This event is a departure from our regular CSCA Competition events in that it is not a Motorsport Australia sanctioned venue but is run under the requirements of ANDA (Australian National Drag Association).

Entries close 3 July 2023.

Please complete the Entry Form Attached and e-mail it to **motorsport @tsoansw.org.au**.

Entry Fee is \$175.00/competitor.

All competitors will be required to complete a Sydney Dragway Entry Form and Disclaimer on the day.

All competitors will be required to subject their vehicle to a Technical Inspection by the Sydney Dragway officials prior to commencing competition runs.

All cars must comply with the following requirements

- Hire is for this type of event is normally for street-registered vehicles only, however we have an agreement with Sydney Dragway to allow non road registered cars that meet the requirements for MA circuit events to be allowed to compete.
- Cars with a known potential to run quicker than 10.00-seconds (1/4 mile) are not permitted
- All drivers must hold a current civil driver's licence as a minimum
- P-plate licences are acceptable; Learner's permits are not acceptable for cars;
- IHRA-licensed drivers must have their IHRA licence number included on entry list, must present their IHRA Licence during registration and race under their IHRA Licence during the hire day
- The Sydney Dragway Café may, or may not, be available for service – hirer to confirm beforehand
- **Drivers must wear** an approved helmet (AS/NZS 1698 minimum as specified in the accompanying Table 1
- Table 1: Off-Street "Road-Going" Cars – Minimum Requirements) with long-sleeved upper body garment, long pants and enclosed shoes. (Clothing must be of fire resistant material as a minimum – no nylon).
- Minimum lap-sash seat belt required (lap-only seat belts are not permitted)
- Any driver running 10.50-seconds or quicker over the quarter-mile will require an IHRA Licence
- Any vehicle manufactured prior to 2008 running 10.50-seconds or quicker over the quarter-mile requires a 4-point roll cage and an IHRA technical inspection

The event will commence at 1000 hours and finish at 1400 hours.

Sydney Dragway will allot run/car numbers on the day which will need to be displayed on the windscreen of your car. Suggest you have white shoe cleaner available for this purpose.
