Entries are now open for the JDCA round of the CSCA Super Sprint series at Sydney Motor Sport Park for Sunday 22nd October 2023 on the Druitt (North) Circuit.

The event is open to financial members of CSCA clubs as listed in the Supplementary Regulations PLUS other CAMS affiliated clubs at the discretion of the secretary.

For this Event, the entry is via CAMS Event Entry through the Member Portal at https://motorsport.org.au and payment will be online via CAMS Credit Card facility.

If you need to withdraw you can do so up to **2 Days** before the event. **No refund for cancellation after that day. Refunds will be less \$10 for administration**

Additionally, you MUST COMPLETE the following TWO (2) Motor Sport Australia documents, sign and scan to jdcasporting-reg@jaguar.org.au

- Self-Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance
- Self-Scrutiny Checklist

Please ensure your Club memberships and CAMS licences are up to date and remember to bring them on the day, as you **MUST** have them on registration in the base of the Control Tower.

When entering the event via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry Portal - please ensure that :

• Your CSCA Reserved Number is Updated. Otherwise, you will be allocated a number.

Note: Drivers with CSCA reserved numbers have number priority if they are entered.

• Your Lap Time is updated for this and other circuits.

All cars will be Scrutineered prior to the Event.

However Log Booked cars must have their Log Books presented to the Chief Scrutineer during scrutineering. They will be checked during the event.

Please note that your car **MUST** be presented *in the state it will run!* Re cameras, data loggers etc CANNOT be added after scrutineering. Take care that tyre sizes, class etc are correctly listed. Remember to make sure your car is presented in a race ready condition. Front and rear Tow hooks fitted and fire extinguishers securely mounted. Please check with your sporting rep if you're unsure of your reserved number. Competition numbers will be available at the scrutineering bay at \$ 2.50 per letter.

Garages and carports are again free for this event. Garages one and two are reserved for officials.

Please note also that those cars we have been placed in group 1 will be required to place their cars on the dummy grip in their respective position prior to the Drivers briefing. Those groupings will be advised prior to the event.

We look forward to receiving your entry.
